**AUTHORIZATION OF COVID-19 AUGUST 2020 RENT RELIEF  
FOR LMHA PUBLIC HOUSING RESIDENTS**

WHEREAS, COVID-19 pandemic has caused worldwide disruption and economic loss for families served by LMHA; and

WHEREAS, some of the relief programs offered by local, state and federal government have been insufficient to the needs of low-income families; and

WHEREAS, many of the relief efforts have given some level of support, LMHA families continue to face mounting bills and inadequate resources; and

WHEREAS, the estimated monthly rent charge for July 2020 rent for LMHA is nearly \$520,000 for approximately 2,400 Public Housing residents; and

WHEREAS, LMHA has identified non-federal fund to be used to offset Public Housing resident rental payments for the month of August 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISVILLE METRO HOUSING AUTHORITY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that the Board authorizes Lisa Osanka, the Executive Director, to take such actions and execute any documents as needed to implement the COVID-19 August Rent Relief in the amount of approximately \$520,000.

## RESOLUTION BACKGROUND STATEMENT

### AUTHORIZATION OF COVID-19 AUGUST 2020 RENT RELIEF FOR LMHA PUBLIC HOUSING RESIDENTS

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#### I. STATEMENT OF FACTS:

The COVID-19 pandemic has caused worldwide disruption hitting especially hard, Louisville Metro low income citizens. LMHA recognizes the impact that this pandemic has had on families. We have offered expedited processing of interim recertifications recognizing families' loss of income.

State and Federal actions have provided minimal economic relief to address the loss of income and additional expenses incurred by families in these times. Protections have been established to waive some regulations, utility payments and to defer eviction actions but rent remains due.

Families continue to experience mounting economic pressures. LMHA recognizes the burden this places upon families and is offering a one-time Rent Relief program waiving rental payments for LMHA managed Public Housing residents.

LMHA has identified non-federal funding sources to be used to abate August 2020 resident rental payments. LMHA will waive approximately \$520,000 in public housing rental payments.

#### II. ALTERNATIVES:

- A. Authorize the Rent Relief Program for the month of August 2020.
- B. Do not authorize the Rent Relief Program for the month of August 2020.

#### III. RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends Alternative "A".

#### IV. JUSTIFICATION:

- Will facilitate economic relief to low-income residents that are in need because of the negative financial impact of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Use of available non-federal funds to support the August Rent Relief Program effort.

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**V. BUDGET APPROVAL:**

Funded with Non-Restricted Program Income funds.
