## **Notice of availability of Stability Vouchers**

- LMHA will be issuing and administering 22 Stability Vouchers.
- Stability Vouchers are issued through a direct referral process with the referrals coming from the Louisville-Jefferson County Continuum of Care.
- Stability Vouchers must be issued to assist households who are:
  - 1) homeless OR
  - 2) at-risk of homelessness OR
  - 3) those fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking OR
  - 4) veterans and families that include a veteran family member that meet one of the proceeding criteria
- Prioritization will be given to families who are homeless and have at least one family member who is a homeless person with a disability.
- First priority will go to those who meet the above criteria and are Long-term Shelter/Encampment Stayers, defined as being in a shelter or an encampment for a minimum of 180 of the past 365 days OR Medically Frail/ER High Utilizers, as indicated as having a CoC Disability Verification indicating a chronic health condition and a letter from a medical provider demonstrating a strong need for housing.
- If you think you meet the Stability Voucher criteria and/or the prioritization plan, you may contact the Louisville-Jefferson County Continuum of Care Assessment Team at 502-637-2080.
